Attorney Information & Notes

If immigration officials come to your home, you do not need to open the door unless they slide a warrant signed by a federal judge or magistrate (not an ICE official) under your door.

Know Your Rights!

Here's what you need to know if you are detained by the police and about going to court...

¡NUNCA hables con la policía!

¡Conozca sus derechos!

Esto es lo que necesita saber acerca de detención policial y de acudir a la corte...

Should I get a lawyer? Yes!

**Say this clearly,
"I want my lawyer."**

**Don't talk to cops: say this,
"I don't want to speak to you."**

**Even if you don't have or can't
afford a lawyer...**

- If you want the best outcome for your case, you should definitely talk to a lawyer.
- If you don't have or can't afford a lawyer, the judge must appoint a lawyer for you.

Don't be afraid to ask questions.

The Prosecutor is not your friend

- The prosecutor works for the state.
- The prosecutor will fight to convict you.

How your lawyer will help:

- YOUR lawyer works for YOU.
- YOUR lawyer will fight for YOU.

Did you know...?

- What you say to your lawyer is a secret.
- What you say to the prosecutor/police will hurt you.

WARNING!

- DON'T talk to anyone that is not your lawyer (including family)
- ALL jail phone calls are recorded.
- Anything you say WILL BE used against you.
- Foreign nationals have the right to speak to the consul from their home country. You may be deported if you are not a U.S. citizen.
- Convictions have consequences.
- A conviction for DWI or Possession of Marijuana will suspend your license to drive.
- You may never legally own a firearm again if you are convicted of Domestic Violence Assault

**¿Debo contratar a un abogado?
¡Sí!**

**Dígalo claramente:
"Quiero a mi abogado".**

**No hables con la policía: di esto,
"No quiero hablar contigo".**

**Incluso si no tiene o no puede
permitirse pagar un abogado...**

- Si desea el mejor resultado para su caso, definitivamente debe hablar con un abogado.
- Si no tiene o no puede permitirse pagar un abogado, la Corte debe designarle uno.

**No tenga miedo de hacer
preguntas.**

El fiscal no es tu amigo

- El fiscal trabaja para el estado.
- El fiscal luchará para condenarlo.

Cómo le ayudará su abogado:

- SU abogado trabaja para USTED.
- SU abogado luchará por USTED.

Sabía...?

- Lo que le diga a su abogado es confidencial.
- Lo que le diga al fiscal/policía le hará daño.

¡ADVERTENCIA!

- NO hable con nadie que no sea su abogado (incluyendo a su familiares)
- TODAS las llamadas telefónicas de la cárcel se graban.
- Cualquier cosa que diga SERÁ usada en su contra.
- Los extranjeros tienen derecho a hablar con el cónsul de su país de origen. Puede ser deportado si no es ciudadano estadounidense.
- Las condenas tienen consecuencias.
- Una condena por DWI o posesión de marihuana suspenderá su licencia para conducir.
- Es posible que nunca podrá volver a poseer legalmente un arma de fuego si será condenado por el delito de agresión por violencia doméstica.

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
